



Rosemarie Tan Ramos

January 24, 1955 - June 24, 2019

Rosemarie Tan Ramos, 64, passed away peacefully at her home in Dublin, CA, on Monday, June 24, 2019, after a nearly two-year battle with Stage IV brain cancer. Her daughters were by her side as she took her last breath.

Known as Rose to friends, and Rosie to family, she was born on January 24, 1955, in Manila, Philippines, to Teofilo Tan and Maria Aurora de la Cruz. She was the oldest of five, with one sister, Marita, and three brothers, Leynard, Rogelio, and Teofilo, Jr. She went to President Sergio Osmena High School and Far Eastern University, where she graduated in 1977 to later become a Registered Nurse. In July, 1979, she immigrated to the United States, living first on the East Coast, before eventually establishing her home in the California Bay Area in 1981. She worked at Fairmont Hospital in San Leandro, CA, as a Rehabilitation Nurse, where she showed compassion and the will to help her patients for 26 years, before retiring in April, 2011.

Rose enjoyed sewing, like her father, gardening, spending time with her college classmates, watching over her two grandsons, and cheering on her favorite team, the Golden State Warriors. She was a selfless, caring, and loving mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, and friend. She is survived by her daughters Priscilla (Christiandi [Budi]) and Kristina (Vicente) -- who was also her devoted caregiver for the last two years. She is also survived by her two grandsons, Jeremiah and Nathaniel. Rose is also survived by her younger sister, three brothers, and her nieces and nephews in the Philippines and Canada.
